

Dear math student,

December 2011

Registration for Winter Quarter has occurred and we hope you have registered for classes. If you want to take classes in Winter Quarter and haven't registered yet, please do so as soon as possible. **This memo is a reminder that a minimum grade of 2.0 is required to take the next level mathematics class as well as several other classes which have mathematics as a prerequisite.**

Therefore, it is important that you check your grade via the Shoreline CC web site ([www.shoreline.edu](http://www.shoreline.edu) ,click on "current students", click on "more options", then "grades"). Grades will be available by Wednesday, December 14<sup>th</sup>. If your grade is below a 2.0, you will not be able to advance to the next level. **We strongly encourage you to change your class registration yourself.** International, Running Start and other special program students will need to contact their advisor right away.

**On Friday December 16<sup>th</sup> the Mathematics Department will review the grades and withdraw students from Winter Quarter math classes for which they don't meet the prerequisite.** This will also happen for **Chem& 121, Econ& 201, Phil& 106, and Phys 110**, all of which have Math 099 with a minimum 2.0 grade as a prerequisite. We urge you to check your registration on the web at "current students", "current quarter schedule".

If you are unsure whether you will pass your current math class, we encourage you to discuss this with your teacher and perhaps also with your advisor as you make plans for next quarter.

Our prerequisite checking policies are designed to provide the best opportunity for success for all students.
