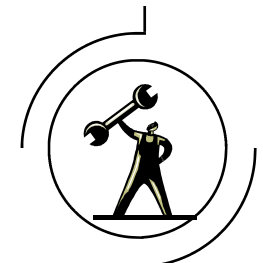

## Where can I take the GST training?

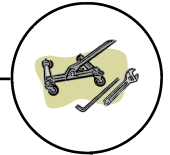
Two classes at Shoreline Community College :
