Group Responsibilities:

The groups will consist of:

Team leader—responsible for directing and focusing the team

Note taker—responsible for entering all pertinent data from meetings in the team journal---including attendance records

Process observer---responsible for reporting the effectiveness of the team

Reporter-- responsible for participation records and verbally reporting information

Introduce yourself to each other. Might be nice to get phone numbers, E-mail addresses and student's schedules so that you can contact each other. Please let your group know if you cannot attend class.

Please allow all members of the group to participate. Remember that you are a **TEAM**.

Information may be obtained from books, magazines, web sites, newspapers, friends, library, etc. Be sure and document your sources.

For the class presentation, you may use overhead transparencies, posters, white board, handouts, verbal, 5x7 note cards (no 8 1/2" x11" paper), and Power Point (limited to five minutes).
