What was going to be required in each class. Some classes are 1 chapter weekly and some are 2-3. Also some classes have weekly assignments and some are spaced out. Also how much is text vs. online. A textbook can be studied anywhere but an online assignment is usually only available at home or sitting in a coffee shop. If I will not be at home often, it will result in loss of study/work time. When taking 3 classes and raising a family it is important to be able to balance everything to succeed. If you register blindly not knowing what is expected in the class you may be overwhelmed. Basically to know the syllabus in advanced so you would have the option of not taking several courses with heavy workloads at the same time or at least be able to consider if you can handle it. To have multiple exams within days and sometimes on the same day is difficult. My instructors have been great and have an open door if assistance or personal consideration is needed and that is nice to have. I was overwhelmed at first but have adjusted to online classes and am really glad they are offered.

That most student participation is lacking. It doesn't make the learning experience interesting when student's and teacher's don't give it there all just because it's not a classroom.

I would have liked to know that you have to be super careful no to click on anything other than the "save answer" or "save and submit" button when taking a test because a not will pop up and no matter if you click "ok" or "cancel" you will be taken out of the test. You should try and fix that. Also I have a suggestion: You should make a better calendar/planner. One that does not go by hour but rather by day. Like a calendar where you can click on each day and see what you have to do for that day, similar to the one in the corner of the Current Students page. You could even put an alert system somewhere on the blackboard front page. This way either the teacher could enter all the important dates at the beginning of the quarter, or the students could. I know that for me it was stressful to have to open the syllabus for each class and scan through it to figure out when something was due. I have missed the due date on an assignment or two because of this system. I think a lot of students and even teachers would benefit from this kind of calendar system.

I have taken online classes before so I knew what I was getting myself into. However, this class was different because the testing schedule is very inconsistent. We had our first exam probably 4 weeks after the term began, then the second one was about 4 weeks later, then the 3rd on was only 2 weeks later but we were expected to learn and test on 6 chapters in two weeks. Usually we were tested on 4 chapters that were covered in a 4 week period. So I would have liked to know the pace of the class especially around the holidays. I feel that i have made sufficient time to study and do well on the tests, but have to learn 6 chapters worth of material in 2 weeks seems a little fast if you want students to actually learn and not just memorize the material. Also, I haven't gotten many assignments' grades yet. We have had a discussion board assignment every week since the first week and we have only gotten the grade for the first one back. It also took over a month to get the grades from the first exam as well. I feel that the turn around time for grades is subpar, especially with online classes. You don't really have a feel for how you are doing in the class, so by waiting so long to get your grade you don't know if your strategy of studying was sufficient or if you need to try something different next time. Also if you didn't know how you were doing in the class grade wise, how would you know if you should drop the class without getting a W on your transcript or a low grade? I feel that the turn around time needs to be improved

I should be able to do my homework up until class, and turn it in with the teacher.

I wish the classes I need to take weren't hybrid. I can't even begin to explain how much I loathe it. As someone who struggles with a.d.d., having to work with blackboard has compromised my grades. PLEASE take this input seriously.

All of my instructors provided a comprehensive guide on how to use the online system.

However, I wish there had been a survey after summer quarter. The absolute WORST class I have ever taken was over the summer, it was CIS 105, computer applications. This class should NOT be an online class as it is structured right now. It should be either not offered online OR broken into two segments. I have spoken to several people about this class and they feel the exact same way. It also appeared that the dropout rate was very high. This class should be thoroughly analyzed! Seriously. Please don't put students through this class as it is now, it's an important class that is too overwhelming and needs a teacher right there in the room, or online hours with you to answer questions---not an email that you receive a email 24 or more hours later. Please do this!

I would have liked to have known why Blackboard changes formatting and how to fix it; some WORD documents that I have pasted into the body look fine before I submit them, but when I review the submission, sometimes the font size has been changed for one or two paragraphs even though my original document is all the same size. Also, most of the time, the spacing between paragraphs has been eliminated after pasting a WORD document, and I have to go through the entire piece and add the spacing back in. When pasting something from EXCEL, I can see it in the body, but after I submit and review, it may either completely disappear and only leave a big blank space where my data had been, or all the cells have been jumbled so that the data looks askew.

It would have been nice to be able to do something about these issues up front instead of spending time trying to find alternate ways of pasting data that would work and also look correct.

For example, I have one online class that takes some very tricky navigation to get into the discussion board, let alone post on it. And, it is not even called the same thing in each class. Another is that I cannot just email the instructor through Bb when I need to do so, let alone with an assignment. Some instructors say to email them, but then when you do, they do not respond at all, so you don't know where things stand. Finally, the instructors are greatly varied as to how diligent they are with grading. I have one that still has yet to grade things from early weeks in the course. So, in terms of my overall grade and what I might possibly need to do to get my grade up (or if I do) is unknown, still. Without in-person access to the instructor to simply ask, it is a little trying. This is my second online class so I knew what I was getting into. My complaints would only be directed at the instructor, but I suppose I was used to my previous instructor and his teaching style. Informing the students for the programs requirements with a sufficient time:

Some online class like (BUSTC 170 Access 2010) required hardware and software requirement, and the time was very short for me to decide what to do, and how to provide the required software, but with the instructor help everything went just fine.

You need an on-line orientation available starting from the registration process. I work full-time during the day (which is paying for these classes) and can't go to the library orientation during day hours. Our instructor has still not utelized those lecture/telus (sp?) features either. Would have liked more "how does this work" info right away.

Nothing in particular. I am 50 years old and this was my first online class. I was a bit nervous, but my 20 year old daughter got most of her A.A. online. That gave me the confidence to try it.
