

Beta Sigma Phi Visual Arts Scholarship

Through the generosity of the Emerald City Council of Beta Sigma Phi, this scholarship is made available to outstanding visual arts students. The scholarship is for tuition and fees related to tuition at Shoreline Community College and/or required texts/materials/supplies available through the SCC Bookstore. One \$500 scholarship will be offered for the 2012 – 2013 school year.

The scholarship has no cash exchange value and is non-transferable. The award must be completed by spring 2013.

Criteria for Eligibility

- ❖ Applicant must be a Washington state resident (as defined by the college).
- ❖ Applicant must have a cumulative 2.5 GPA from previous schools and/or maintain a cumulative 2.5 GPA at SCC; and have a minimum 3.0 GPA in visual studio art courses at SCC.
- ❖ Applicant can be a part-time or full-time student.
- ❖ Applicant need not be a fine arts major.

Application Procedures

To be considered, each applicant must submit **4** copies of the following in collated packets: (Please type)

1. Completed **Application** (OK to be handwritten)
2. Completed **Budget Worksheet** (attached – OK to be handwritten)
3. High school and/or college **Transcripts** through winter 2012 (Unofficial are OK).
4. **Artist Statement**: Describe the importance of studying art for your educational and personal goals (one page).
5. **Artist Biography**: Describe the experiences and influences in your life that have led you make art a part of your life.(one page)
6. **References**: Provide contact information for a minimum of two individuals, who are not related to you, who can speak of your qualifications for this scholarship. Identify how they are in a position to do so (ie “high school art instructor”)
7. Five to seven **Images** of your most recent art. Submit these as digital images on a CD in jpg format at 300 dpi and at least 6” in one dimension, or as 8 ½ x 11 prints. Please put your name on the CD or name on the back of your prints.
8. Include an **Annotate List** of your images on a separate paper (see attached example)

The selection committee will screen the applications. Applicants may be asked to interview.

Recipient will be required to attend the SCC Foundation Award Presentation.
