He was working towards an Associate of Science Degree and planning to transfer to a 4-year College to pursue a degree in Environmental Science with emphasis in Geology. His progress towards his dream career was tragically interrupted by his premature death. This scholarship is given to assist promising students to carry on Eric's dream and continue their studies in Earth or Environmental Science (i.e. Geology, Environmental Science, Geography or Oceanography)

The Shoreline Community College Foundation, on behalf of family and friends who wish to honor Eric's memory; are offering the Eric Niemitalo Memorial Scholarship to one student majoring in environmental science or geology in the amount of \$500 dollars.

This scholarship is to be used for tuition and fees related to tuition on or before March 2013 at Shoreline Community College. The scholarship has no cash exchange value and is non-transferable.

Criteria for Eligibility

Applicant must:

- Be a Washington state resident (as defined by the college).
- Have completed at least 15 credits at Shoreline Community College
- Be presently enrolled at SCC for at least 12 credits
- Have completed at least one course at Shoreline Community College in one of the following subject areas: Geology, Environmental Science, Geography or Oceanography
- Intend to pursue a degree in Earth or Environmental Science at an accredited college or university
- Be in Good Academic Standing
- Demonstrate financial need

Application Procedures

To be considered, each applicant must submit **4** copies of all of the following in collated packets:

1. Completed application
2. Budget Worksheet
3. Statement regarding current financial need
4. Unofficial Shoreline Community College transcript through winter 2012
5. One page typed essay describing your interest in Earth or Environmental Science and your professional goals

Recipient will be required to attend the SCC Foundation award presentation.
