The Friends of Mary Automotive Scholarship was established by the friends and family of Mary Nelson who was a graduate of Shorewood High School and attended Shoreline Community College. Mary worked at Schuck's Auto Supply. This scholarship in memory of Mary and her love of autos and driving; is intended to provide financial assistance to women currently enrolled in the Shoreline Community College automotive program. One \$750 scholarship will be offered for use at SCC beginning with fall quarter 2012. The award may be used for tuition, or associated school fees at Shoreline Community College or required textbooks, and/or other professional fees.

This award has no cash exchange value and is non-transferable. The award expires spring 2013.

Criteria for Eligibility

- Be a returning female student at Shoreline Community College
- Be a Washington State resident (as defined by the college).
- Have completed a minimum of two quarters in the SCC automotive program.
- Have earned and maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 at SCC.
