

High School Academic Scholarship

The Shoreline Community College Foundation will offer five \$1,000.00 scholarships to graduating Washington State high school seniors enrolling in Shoreline Community College for the academic year 2012-2013.

The High School Academic scholarship is available for students who demonstrate strong academic performance, leadership qualities and involvement in school and community activities.

Scholarships are for SCC tuition and fees related to tuition, books and required materials available through the SCC Bookstore, and /or parking permits.

The scholarship has no cash exchange value and is non-transferable. The award expires June 2013.

Criteria for Eligibility

- ❖ Applicant must be a Washington State resident (as defined by the college).
- ❖ Applicant must be a graduating senior during the 2011-2012 school year with a minimum 3.2 grade point average during his/her junior and senior year of high school.
- ❖ Applicant must plan to attend Shoreline Community College full-time (12 credits or more/quarter) in 2012-2013.
- ❖ Applicant must display academic excellence, leadership, and/or involvement in school and community activities.

Application Procedures

To be considered, each applicant must submit **2** copies of the following in collated packets:
(Please type)

1. Completed application (OK to be handwritten)
2. Two letters of recommendation from non-related adults, of which at least one is from a school counselor or teacher.
3. Copy of high school transcripts (Unofficial is OK) through fall 2011.
4. A one page personal essay stating your qualifications, including; career interests, personal background, educational and personal goals

Recipient will be required:

1. To attend SCC full-time and maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA each quarter in order to maintain their scholarship.
2. Attend the SCC Foundation Award Presentation.
