**Joseph Wood Rogers  
Memorial Scholarship in Mathematics**

Joe Rogers was an associate faculty at Shoreline Community College. He received his PhD in electrical engineering, but his true passion was mathematics. This scholarship is given to assist promising students to continue their studies in mathematics.

The Shoreline Community College Foundation, on behalf of family and friends who wish to honor Joe's memory, will make available the Joseph Wood Rogers Memorial Scholarship to one outstanding mathematics student in the amount of \$1,000. This scholarship is to be used for tuition on or before spring quarter 2013 at an accredited four-year college or university of the recipient's choice.

*The scholarship has no cash exchange value and is non-transferable.*

**Criteria for Eligibility**

Applicant must:

- Be a Washington state resident (as defined by the college).
- Have completed at least 30 credits at Shoreline Community College.  
Have completed at least two mathematic courses at or above the calculus level at SCC.
- Have at least a 3.5 grade point average in mathematic courses taken at SCC.
- Intend to pursue a degree in mathematics at an accredited college or university.
- Show promise of continued growth in mathematics.

**Application Procedures**

To be considered, each applicant must submit **4** copies of the following in collated packets:

1. Completed application.
2. Unofficial Shoreline Community College transcript through winter 2012.
3. One to two page essay describing your interest in mathematics and your professional goals.
4. Permission to contact all math instructors.
5. Name of three references (outside of Shoreline's math faculty) their phone numbers, email addresses and their relationship to you (do not include family members).

Recipient will be required to attend the SCC Foundation award presentation.

Applicants may be asked to interview.
