Rick Kaminski was an SCC Alumni who was SCC's Student Body President during 1973-1974. Rick was known to many as the Seattle Mariners beloved "Peanut Man". This scholarship was established in memory of Rick and his support of Seattle sports teams and will offer financial support to SCC student athletes who also show strong leadership traits.

The Shoreline Community College Foundation, on behalf of family and friends who wish to honor Rick's memory; are offering the Rick Kaminski Memorial Athletic Scholarship to one student in the amount of \$1,000 dollars. Award can be applied toward tuition and or fees related to tuition at SCC, required textbooks or supplies from the SCC Bookstore, bus passes and/or SCC parking permits.

This award has no cash exchange value and is non-transferable. Award must be used by June, 2013.

Criteria for Eligibility

Applicant must:

- Be a U.S. citizen or legal U.S. resident or permanent U.S. resident with an I-551 Card or a student in F-1 nonimmigrant status.
- Have completed at least 15 credits at Shoreline Community College
- Be registered as a returning full or part-time student at Shoreline Community College
- Be an active participant on an SCC competitive athletic team
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Be in good standing with the College
- Demonstrate strong leadership traits.

Application Procedures

To be considered, each applicant must submit **5** copies of all of the following in collated packets: (please type)

1. Completed application (OK to be handwritten)
2. Unofficial Shoreline Community College transcript through winter 2012
3. Copy of Permanent U.S. Resident (I-551) Card or passport, I-20 & I-94 documents (if applicable).
4. One page typed essay describing how being on an SCC athletic team is contributing to your educational and personal goals.
5. A letter of recommendation from a coach or an instructor describing your leadership traits.
6. Names of three references including email addresses and phone numbers.

Recipient will be required to attend the SCC Foundation award presentation.
