The Shoreline Community College Foundation is making the Ron LaFreniere Business Administration Scholarship available to one student in the amount of \$1,000.00. This scholarship will be awarded for use beginning Fall Quarter 2012 and must be used for tuition, books, and/or class related fees on or before April 2013 at Shoreline Community College.

This award has no cash exchange value and is non-transferable.

Criteria for Eligibility

- Applicant must be a Washington state resident (as defined by the college).
- Applicant must have completed a minimum of two quarters at SCC and taken at least 12 credits in Business Administration.
- Applicant must have a strong emphasis of study in Business Administration
- Applicant must have a minimum SCC cumulative grade point average of 2.8.
- Applicant must have applied for Financial Aid.

Application Procedures

To be considered, each applicant must submit **4** copies of the following in collated packets: (please type)

1. Completed application (OK to be handwritten)
2. Unofficial Shoreline Community College transcript through winter 2012.
3. Student financial aid report available after you complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on-line through fafsa.ed.gov.
4. One page personal essay summarizing:
Your career interests, personal background, educational goals.
5. Names of three references, their phone numbers and/or email addresses and their relationship to you
(do not include family members).

Recipient will be required to attend the SCC Foundation Award Presentation.
