Peggy O'Coyne Memorial Music Scholarship

This scholarship, named in memory of Peggy O'Coyne, who served as Music Department secretary from 1983 to 1990, was established by the Shoreline Community College Music Department. This scholarship was established to assist students who wish to pursue degrees and/or careers in music. Ms. O'Coyne was known for her steadfast loyalty and support for literally hundreds of music students at Shoreline Community College. The Shoreline Community College Foundation will make available five \$750.00 scholarships to students who plan to study at Shoreline Community College during the 2012 - 2013 year and meet the eligibility criteria. The awards will be for SCC tuition and/or fees, books and required materials and/or SCC parking permits.

The scholarship has no cash exchange value and is non-transferable. The award expires June 2013.

Criteria for Eligibility

- ❖ Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or legal U.S. resident or permanent U.S. resident with an I-551 Card or a student in F-1 nonimmigrant status.
- ❖ Applicant can be a new or current SCC student enrolled in the music department.
- ❖ Applicant must have and maintain a GPA of 3.0 or better in all music courses.
- ❖ Applicant must plan to be enrolled at SCC in a minimum of 6 credits per quarter during the 2012 – 2013.
- ❖ Applicant must perform in at least one major ensemble each quarter (Chorale, Shoreline Singers, Jazz Ensemble, Concert Band).

Application Procedures

To be considered, each applicant must submit **4** copies of the following in collated packets: (Please type)

1. Completed application form. (OK to be handwritten)
2. Copy of Permanent U.S. Resident (I-551) Card or passport, I-20 & I-94 documents (if applicable).
3. Resume of musical activities.
4. Short essay describing student's goals for the future.
5. Two letters of recommendation (one academic and one music instructor preferred).
6. Applicants will be asked to perform a live audition piece for the selection committee

Scholarship funds will be available for use beginning fall quarter 2012. Awards are not transferable and must be used at Shoreline Community College. The funds will be disbursed in three equal installments for fall, winter, and spring quarters.

Music scholarship recipients are expected to meet the eligibility criteria each quarter in order to maintain the scholarship.

AUDITION DATE: April 20, 2012 – Those chosen to audition, will be contacted and scheduled a time.

Peggy O’Coyne Memorial Music Scholarship

Thank you for your interest in Shoreline Community College Music Department. Please make sure your application is received in the SCC Foundation office by 4:00pm - April 6, 2012. Those selected will be assigned an audition time soon thereafter.

All scholarship recipients are required to enroll in a minimum of 6 credit hours at the college and maintain a 3.0 GPA in all music classes. Music scholarship recipients are expected to participate in at least one major ensemble each quarter (Chorale, Shoreline Singers, Jazz Ensemble, Concert Band).

Your audition will consist of performing one piece for the scholarship committee. You will have about five minutes for your performance. You will not be asked to play scales, arpeggios, or other technical exercises, nor will you be asked to sight-read. The scholarship is based on your performance ability.

Your audition piece should be one that best displays your performance abilities. For most areas, your piece should be taken from the classical repertoire. Should you have a question as to the appropriateness of your selection, please contact the following faculty:

Make sure your application is complete. Include anything you feel is pertinent regarding your accomplishments.

Scholarship decisions usually take 3 weeks. We will notify all applicants of the committee’s decision. Award winners will be given 4 weeks to accept their scholarship after which time the scholarship may be awarded to another applicant.

Award recipients will be honored at the Spring Scholarship Celebration on May 16 2012 on the SCC campus.
