Scholarship Information

The Study Abroad Scholarship Committee will offer up to a maximum of 5 study abroad scholarships. The awards will range from \$300 to \$1000. Awards are for use on SCC Summer Institutes and BASW Denmark Programs only and must be used in the year they are awarded. Award amounts will be determined by the Study Abroad Scholarship Committee and will be based on the quality of the personal resume, essay, and transcript. Additionally, the committee will weigh the following factors: the student's financial need, biographical status, and the cost of the study abroad program.

Scholarships are non-renewable. The scholarship dollars will be applied to the final payment of the program fee. Award payments will be made to the College on behalf of the recipient. Scholarship recipients are asked to work with the Assistant Director of International Education upon return with one small project to share their study abroad experience with other students (for example talking at a study abroad info meeting, sharing photos or writings for use on the school website.)

Applications are DUE by 4pm on Thursday, March 29, 2012.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must have been enrolled at Shoreline at least 2 quarters between Fall 2010 and Winter 2012.
- Must be applying to or accepted into a 2012 SCC Summer Institute or BASW Denmark Study Abroad Program
- Must be a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident
- Must show Financial Need (as determined by FAFSA) **AND/OR** be from a population that is underrepresented in Study Abroad programs. This includes students who are any of the following: 1) male 2) non-Caucasian, or 3) 24 years or older.

Application Requirements:

- Completed Application Form with Signature
- Current Unofficial SCC Transcript
- Essay
- Resume

Determination of Award:

The application will be reviewed by the Study Abroad Scholarship Committee. Recipients will be notified of their award no later than April 15th, 2012.

Award Recognition

Scholarship Recipients will be recognized Wednesday, May 16, 2012 at the SCC Foundation Spring Scholarship Celebration.
