**Mark Galloway
Automotive Scholarship**

Mark Andrew Galloway was a 2006 graduate of Monroe High School and Sno-Isle Auto Technician Training Program where he was Student of the Year and a member of the National Technical Vocational Honor Society. He was working on his Associate of Arts degree from the General Motors Automotive Service Educational Program at Shoreline Community College and worked at Speedway Chevrolet in Monroe as a Service Technician and Performance Consultant at the time of his tragic death. This scholarship, established in memory of Mark; will be offered to a student in the GM-ASEP Program at Shoreline Community College, with preference being given to a graduate, or soon to be graduate of the Sno-Isle Auto Technician Training Program. One \$1,000 grant will be provided to the recipient toward the purchase of automotive tools and/or supplies, SCC tuition and/or textbooks at SCC.

This award has no cash exchange value and is non-transferable. The award expires June 2016.

Criteria for Eligibility

- ❖ Applicant must be a Washington State resident (as defined by the college).
- ❖ Applicant must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- ❖ Applicant must have applied to SCC.
- ❖ Applicant must be accepted into and/or enrolled in the Shoreline Community College GM-ASEP program.
- ❖ Applicant cannot be related in the first degree to a person on the selection committee.
- ❖ Preference given to a graduate or soon to be graduate of the Sno-Isle Auto Tech Training Program.

Application Requirements

To be considered, each applicant must submit **four** collated packets (typed). Each packet must include:

1. Completed **Application**.
2. Current **Class Schedule**.
3. Most recent **High School or SCC Unofficial Transcript**.
4. **One page essay** on your career goals in the auto industry.
5. **Letter of recommendation** from an auto instructor or employer (service manager, mentor tech, etc.).
