- 3. Take your admission letters, along with your I-20 document, to the U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for your F-1 visa.
- 4. Enroll at Shoreline and finish the first half of your bachelor's degree by earning an A.A. or A.S. degree.
- 5. Transfer to Seattle University to finish the second half of your bachelor's degree.
- Complete your bachelor's degree at Seattle University!

Conditional Guaranteed Transfer Admission to Seattle University Requires:

- Earn a minimum of 90 credits and a 3.0 cumulative GPA on transferrable credit from all previous institutions prior to beginning at Seattle University;
- Meet Seattle University's English language proficiency requirements; and
- Submit a complete transfer application and provide copies of all transcripts, adhering to deadlines for application and document submission and admission policies.

NOTE: This agreement does not guarantee admission to all undergraduate degree programs within the university. Individual programs of study may impose higher admission requirements.
