- 3. Take your admission letters, along with your I-20 document, to the U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for your F-1 visa.
- 4. Enroll at Shoreline and finish the first half of your bachelor's degree by earning an associate degree.
- 5. Transfer to the University of Missouri to finish your bachelor's degree!

University of Missouri Transfer Admission Guarantee Requirements:

- Complete an Associate in Arts degree at Shoreline Community College;
- Maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of at least 2.50 on all academic coursework;
- Meet the University of Missouri's English proficiency requirement by completing at least 24 transferrable credits at Shoreline; some majors may require additional evidence of English proficiency: http://admissions.missouri.edu/apply-international/english-language-requirements/;
- Meet the University of Missouri's math requirement by earning a grade of C- (1.7) or higher in a transferrable math course (intermediate algebra or higher or statistics);
- Submit a completed transfer application by the application deadline for the intended transfer semester.
