TRANSFER ADMISSION PATHWAY TO:



It's simple!

- 1. Apply for admission to Shoreline Community College. Indicate your interest in the Transfer Admission Pathway to the University of California at Riverside on your Shoreline application.
- 2. Receive an admission letter from Shoreline Community College, as well as a Transfer Admission Pathway participation letter to UC Riverside, AT THE SAME TIME! (Please note that the pathway participants are very likely to be admitted, but are <u>not</u> guaranteed admission to UC Riverside.)
- 3. Take your letters, along with your I-20 document, to the U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for your F-1 visa.
- 4. Enroll at Shoreline and finish the first half of your bachelor's degree by earning an A.A. or A.S. degree.
- 5. Apply to UC Riverside and, if accepted, transfer there to finish the second half of your bachelor's degree. Scholarships of up to \$13,500 per year, or \$4,500 per quarter, are available for international students with a 3.0 GPA and above!
- 6. Complete your bachelor's degree at the University of California at Riverside!

The Transfer Admission Pathway to UC Riverside Requires:

To secure your place at UC Riverside, you must meet the following guidelines:

- 1. Complete a total of 90 transferable quarter credits by the end of spring quarter for fall start and by the end of fall quarter for winter start.
- 2. Complete ENGL 101 and 102, one transferrable course in math, and four transferrable courses from at least two of the following subject areas: arts and humanities, social and behavioral sciences, and physical and biological sciences, with grades of 2.0 or better, by the end of fall quarter.
- 3. Complete ENGL 101 or ENGL 102 with a 2.0 or better to meet English proficiency requirements.
- 4. Meet all major selection requirements.
- 5. Meet the minimum transferable GPA requirement of 2.80.
- 6. Submit an official University of California application by the appropriate deadlines of January 3rd for fall start and July 31st for winter start.
