

## **Professor Emeritus Dr. Bill Johnson Memorial Scholarship**

Dr. Johnson was a professor of mathematics at Shoreline Community College for 25 years. He had a strong commitment to student success and was always willing and available to help students in the sometimes perplexing world of mathematics.

The Shoreline Community College Foundation, on behalf of family and friends who wish to honor his memory, will make available the Dr. Johnson Memorial Scholarship to two students in the amount of \$700 each. This scholarship will be awarded for use fall quarter 2009 and may be used for tuition, books, and/or class related fees at Shoreline Community College.

*The Dr. Johnson Memorial Scholarship has no cash exchange value and is non-transferable.*

### **Criteria for Eligibility**

- Applicant must be a Washington state resident (as defined by the college).
- Applicant must be within three quarters of graduation with a transferable degree to a four-year university or college.
- Applicant must have a strong emphasis of study in mathematics or science. (Mathematics preferred)
- Applicant must have a minimum cumulative SCC grade point average of 2.8.
- Applicant must have applied for Financial Aid

### **Application Procedures**

To be considered, each applicant must submit all of the following to the Foundation Office by the deadline date.

1. Completed application (back of this page)
2. Official Shoreline Community College transcript
3. Copy of student aid report available through the Financial Aid office
4. Personal essay under 250 words to answer the following question:  
What role will mathematics or science play in your future plans, and why is that important?

Recipient will be required to attend the SCC Foundation award presentation.
