

SHORELINE COMMUNITY COLLEGE PIANO SCHOLARSHIPS

Piano scholarships are given to deserving students for private study of **classical piano** with the following instructors: Helena Azevedo, Jensina Byington, Tamara Friedman, Nancy Matesky, and Dr. Dainius Vaicekonis. Piano scholarships are funded from the proceeds of the Faculty Piano Recital Series and from generous donors.

CRITERIA:

- GPA of 2.5, with a 3.0 in Music at Shoreline Community College. If this is your first quarter at Shoreline, grade point applies to high school, or last college attended.
- Audition:
 1. Play one classical piano solo – **memorized**
 2. Sight-read (for new students only)
- Applicants need not be a full-time student or a Shoreline student the quarter they apply, but must plan to be a full-time student at Shoreline, taking at least 12 credits, during the quarter for which they receive a piano scholarship.
- Applicants must be living in Washington State at the time of application.
- Applicants will be assessed on musical talent, financial need, academic record and recommendation(s).

OTHER REQUIREMENTS AND INFORMATION:

- Scholarship recipients must take **lessons on campus, for credit, and play a jury** each quarter, which is the scholarship audition for the next quarter.
- Music major status is not required but given preference.
- Piano majors are given preference over other majors.
- Piano majors must be taking Music Theory or have completed 1st and 2nd year Music Theory.
- All scholarships will go towards partial payment of lesson fees as determined by the length of lesson. The remaining balance will be paid by the student, to the teacher, by the 2nd week of the quarter.
- Scholarship students must register for the level assigned (Music 180 or 280) before the end of the first week of the quarter.
- When registering the student is responsible for paying for the two credits and a piano tuning fee.
- Piano scholarship students will be asked to help at the SCC Faculty Piano Recital Series.
- **Complete applications** must be received by 2:30 p.m. two weeks before piano juries. Auditions will be held immediately preceding piano juries. **SEE DATES BELOW. NO EXCEPTIONS.**
