Admission and Applications

There are Admission processes for the BSN Program. The priority closing date for Regular Admission applications is February 1st. Files completed after February 1st are reviewed on a space available basis.

The Admission process requires:

- A completed application. Complete applications include three professional references on OC reference forms, a goal statement, a resume and the application fee of \$35.00 and two official transcripts from every college attended;
- Completion of the Associate's Degree in Nursing with a minimum cumulative gpa of 2.5 prior to entering the BSN Program; and
- Proof of current unencumbered licensure for practice as a Registered Nurse in Washington State prior to the first clinical course in the BSN Program.
