



Shoreline Community College Facility Rental Rates

CLASSROOMS

Media Technician required for use of AV equipment/projectors

Base Rate

2 hour minimum

0 - 40 persons: \$40/hour
41 - 85 persons: \$50 /hour
85 - 126 persons: \$60 /hour

Non-Profit & Alumni

2 hour minimum

0 - 40 persons: \$30/hour
41 - 85 persons: \$40/hour
85 - 126 persons: \$50/hour

THEATER 360 person capacity

Theater Technician required (including set-up/tear down)

Lobby access included in rental fee for theater (may not be rented separately for events).

Stage equipment included:

- Basic stage light wash of white, see addendum for details
- 5.1 Dolby surround sound audio system, blue ray,
- Green room #1524 monitor synced to stage production
- Risers available
- Grand piano (as is—special tuning \$30)
- Extra charges for orchestra pit removal/setup
- Extra charges up to 4 wired mics included

Concessions equipment and/or staffing available upon request.

Additional fees may apply for rental of concessions equipment, costumes, props, staging, special lighting, etc.

*Rehearsal rate is 50% off of the standard rental fee, other discounts do not apply, and only if rehearsal dates/times are scheduled on non-performance days. Lighting Designer may be hired for additional fees if your lighting requirements exceed standard options.

FILMING & RECORDING ON CAMPUS

- Some locations on campus and after hours film projects will require supervision
- Portable lighting system and other film/audio recording equipment not provided by the college.
- Charges and Fees to be determined based on the project scope and location
- Parking fees will be assessed depending on time of rental

Note that SCC staff and Alumni will receive the “non-profit” rate if renting college facilities for non-college functions. All other fees and facility charges will apply at the regular rates. State and other government agencies will receive a discount of 50% off regular facility rental rates, but not for required college services, equipment, and personnel.

PUB #9000 BUILDING

After hour/weekend/holiday supervision required
25% discount: groups or individuals who qualify as non-profit status and/or are college affiliated

Small Dining Room

Capacity 80 with table seating, 90 theater style setup

Main Dining Room

Capacity 320 seated at 40 round tables, set banquet style with stage
350 legal maximum capacity when room is set with chairs only, theater style setup

Small Dining Room Base Rate

Weekday: \$80/hour
Weekend/Holiday: \$100/hour
Supervisor \$22–\$25/hour

Main Dining Room Base Rate

Weekday: \$160/hour

ATHLETIC FACILITIES

Discounts may apply for multiple days reserved, multi-hour and multi-day events. Floor cloth required for non-athletic events in the gymnasium spaces. Equipment such as volleyball nets and balls may be rented. Athletic Department approval required for all outside rental use. Supervision and Custodial fees required.

Main Gym: 2 courts (1200 capacity) for athletic events ONLY + additional charge of \$50/hour apply for non-athletic events

Base Rate

\$70/hour for full gym #3021/3022
\$40/hour for half gym (1 court)

Non-Profit & Alumni

\$60/hour for full gym #3021/3022
\$35/hour for half gym (1 court)

COMPUTER LABS

Lab Media Technician required

18 – 30 stations
Includes 1 teacher computer station

Base Rate

\$150/hour (4 hour minimum)+ Lab Tech @ \$30/hour

Non-Profit & Alumni

\$115/hour + Lab Tech @ \$30/hour

AUTO SHOWROOM 2101

Supervision required for after hours & weekend bookings

Base Rate

\$60/hour + Supervisor @ \$25/hour

Non-Profit & Alumni

\$45/hour + Supervisor @ \$25/hour

MUSIC BUILDING #8000

Supervision required for after hours & weekend bookings

Classrooms include upright/grand pianos

Performance hall #818 seats 80 chairs on risers with a grand piano. Practice piano rooms and computer labs cannot be rented to outside users without special permission

PARKING LOT

Reserved parking for rental events will be charged to the client. Guest parking will also be charged accordingly per stall. The college cannot individually invoice guest parking— regular day use parking rates will apply.
