


Use PuTTY to set up your web site on ADA

possible Putty alternative for mac: Under Applications > Utilities , You can make a SSH connection through the Terminal. Or, in spotlight, just type 'Terminal'. Open the terminal, type ssh @ and hit enter. Provide a password

Step	Prompt (or feedback from computer)	What you should do or type	Notes
1		start Putty (winscp/Commands)	On campus, try Start/All Programs/Security in some labs or look for the ssh utilities/PortaPuTTY folder on the L: drive \\cookies. At home, open the folder where you installed the secure tools.
2		Enter ada.shoreline.edu as the Host Name Press the Open button.	
3	login as:	enter your assigned userID First and last Initial, e.g. eh for Ed Hyde	Remember to press the enter key to send what you type to the machine.
4@ada.shoreline.edu's password:	enter your password	you will not see any change on the screen when you type the password
5		passwd	Only on your first login, you need to create a new password to replace the one I gave you
6	old pswd	re-enter the password I gave you	
7	new pswd	enter your new password	write down your new pasword someplace safe
8	new pswd	re-enter you new password	this ensures that you did not make a typo
9		cd	ensure that you are in your root directory
10		pwd	should print your home directory name
11		cd ..	move up one level to the "home" directory
12		chmod 755 {your userID}	Ed Hyde would type: chmod 755 eh
13		cd	go back to your home direcotry
14		pwd	should print your home directory name
15		mkdir web	you must use lowercase letters. You must put all your web files in this web folder; otherwise no one will see them on the web.
16		chmod 755 web	this makes you web folder readable by anyone.
17		cd web	change directory to your web folder
18		ls -l	list all files for this folder (none yet)
19		exit	log out and close the conection to ada. Close putty
20			You should only need to set your new password and create the web folder once. After these steps succeed, do not do them again. If a step does not succeed, you must figure out why and fix it before trying to do anything else with web pages. Review these instructions and the video and contact me if you still cannot fix problems.
