SCC Students on Campus Committees is a project of Student Government. Students are encouraged to serve on the college committees as student representatives (SRs). SRs will share student voices and perspectives to the committees, that are advisory to the college administration, as inputs for decision-makings of the college.

Three major purposes of the project:

- 1) To provide an opportunity for students to participate in social, cultural, recreational and educational experiences outside the classroom.
- 2) To prepare students for leadership roles and encourage students to take leadership positions on campus.
- 3) To provide Student Parliament members and college committees with an access to student perspectives.

Student Representative Duties

As a student representative who serves on a campus committee, I will:

- ❖ Attend the committee meetings and be the voice on behalf of Shoreline Students.
- ❖ Do other work necessary to make the committee function effectively.
- ❖ Communicate effectively with a representative from Student Government on my committee.
- ❖ Join meetings with the Student Body Association (SBA) as needed.
- ❖ Remain active on the committee at least through out the whole quarter.

Benefit for Participating as a Student Representative

- Receive a Student Leadership t-shirt.
- Receive a certificate of appreciation signed by the SBA President and a college administrator.
- Enhance your resume and transfer application.
- Develop leaderships and communication skills.

Details of the SCC Students on the Campus Committees Project

I. Participation in committee meetings

SRs shall attend the every committee meetings. If SRs are going to be absent, please inform the representative of the student parliament (Please see the 3rd page). SRs can find the parliament members as mentors to discuss about issues/concerns, or to collaborate to address issues/concerns, or make a recommendation to the college.

II. Participation in the SBA special meetings

With the purpose to create the sense of community between Shoreline students/student representatives and SBA, for fall quarter, **SRs are expected to join the special meetings with the SBA (Date and Time is to be announced).**

III. Meeting with a representative from Student Government on my Committee

With the purpose to create a meaningful relationship and effective communication between students on committee and student government, **SRs are expected to meet regularly with a representative from Student Government.**
