I. Grad Update- CaryAnn

II. Outback- Scott and Juliane

IV. Open positions

- Co-Treasurer and fundraising committee brought up.

- Questions were brought up on how to take a position and if there is an election. Scott- there would be an election if there were more people voting for the same position. Currently, if there is an open position, one can just take it.
- More questions raised about the fundraising committee. Sharon: holds fundraisers for both the community as well as SCCANS.

V. Nurse's Day- Sarah Fullman

- National Theme is "Building a Healthy America."
- Co-VPs in charge and would like feedback or ideas sent to them.
- Because of theme, may coordinate with next qtrs 5th qtr program for the outreach education section.
- Ideas: cards to clinical sights
- Juliane- any ideas on how to announce/post and get the info to the qtrs. Possible survey to understand why students do not actively participate in SCCANS. A noticeable decrease in people coming to events since food is no longer allowed.
- Scott: We're thinking to combine the Outback Event w/ the Nurse's day.
- Juliane: Brought up the point of having everyone to pay to come. Teachers will be willing, but Nurses day is also for them.
- Various ideas: pay for faculty; cards given instead of flowers. Sharon- suggested a wall sign left out for the students to sign, similar to the last Nurse's day.
- Juliane- Good idea to combine Outback with this? Capacity of banquet Hall at Outback?
- Other ideas: Free mic for instructors instead of guest speaker, no pressure. Keynote speaker, suggestions? Jamie M- may know someone, will contact to see if interested. Sharon- in the past, keynote speakers were people like president of the KCNA, or first black Shoreline Grad...
- Juliane to Sharon: Asking of the idea to survey the students to find barriers in becoming an active member. Find ways to make SCCANS more "fun." Sharon- Also brought up the timing of the Teachers meetings, and how in the Fall it will change so they will be more available during these times.

VI. Game room- Juliane

- Via the United Club council, there is the possibility of Shoreline having a game room. If interested, contact Juliane, and she has a form.
- Sharon- what about the budget cuts? Juiane- they had to cut the fundings for the proctor, but the Game Club on campus is pushing for this.

VII. Tuition increase- Juliane

- WA State will increase tuition 8-11%.
- Need to write letters to Christine Gregoire. In letter, write to how much in terms of numbers this will affect ability to pay, and cause a decrease in grades.
- Sharon- School computers can not be used for anything political.
