Angie began the meeting by asking everyone to introduce themselves.

2. The Outback Fundraiser has sold about 150 tickets and collected about \$2000 (some of which has been donated). Please turn in money for tickets sold to Sharon by Tuesday, 10/15. All money for tickets is due on Wednesday, but people can pay cash at the door.
3. The Welcome Luncheon was received with a lot of enthusiasm. 1<sup>st</sup> quarter students that attended the SCCANS meeting reported that they had fun. Feedback was given to Sharon that a student from another quarter was told not to eat because the food was for 1<sup>st</sup> quarter students only. This should be prevented in the future. Scheduling with the library presentation was an issue, so 1<sup>st</sup> quarter students were later than expected and other quarters had to wait to get food after the 1<sup>st</sup> quarter students had the opportunity to go through the line first. There was enough food for everyone.
4. Brown Bags are scheduled for 10/22, 10/29, 11/5 and 11/19.

5. The Pulse is looking for submissions. They are especially looking for cultural content. Chris Duong offered to write something from a culturally diverse perspective for the next issue. The deadline is November 12, 2007. Submissions should be given to class representatives or to Kat Wright as Word documents. The Pulse will be sent to the printer on November 26<sup>th</sup>.
6. Graduation is taking place on December 10<sup>th</sup>. Invitations and cakes need to be ordered. Punch and flowers need to be bought. Megan will be taking care of the media. There will be a sign up sheet for graduation volunteers at the next meeting. Simi will talk to 6<sup>th</sup> quarter for input about what they want to have at Graduation.
7. The United Club Council met last week and gave out Club Manuals outlining the new budget which gives each club a base budget of \$575. Supplemental money will be applied for each quarter instead of per year. This way we will know 2 weeks after applying for the money if our request was approved. For Fall, and Winter quarters submissions need to be made by week 8. In the Spring quarter the deadline is week 3.
8. The uniform sales made \$160. We still have more uniform and will have another sale for 1<sup>st</sup> quarter students, possibly on November 28<sup>th</sup>, when the new students will have Orientation.
9. Elections will be held next meeting, November 26<sup>th</sup>. Open positions include both co-president and both co-vice president spots as well as advisory committee (which meets fall and spring), eval committee, brown bag. The Job Fair will become a responsibility of the Co-VPs and will be held Winter quarter.
10. Martha Kreiner came up with an idea for a way to get involved in the community. Plymouth Housing is opening a new building for homeless seniors scheduled for March and they could use some diabetic friendly treat bags (mixed nuts, little mirrors for checking feet, flip flops for the shower, socks, sugar free candy). Martha will bring a wish list to classes. We will discuss this further after the Outback and Holiday Family Fund Drive are over and try to get Pre Med Club and Women's Center involved.
11. The Club Kick-off is on Teusday, October 23 from 11-1 pm in the lower level of the library. We have posters from the Splash event that took place in the spring. The co presidents encourage us all to come hangout and see what the other clubs are doing. T shirts will be sold at the event.
