ASSOCIATE IN FINE ARTS - PHOTOGRAPHY

The AFA degree in Photography requires 107 quarter credits in courses numbered 100 or above and a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher. Students granted the degree meet all of the requirements of the Washington State Direct Transfer Agreement and can expect some priority in admission as a transfer student to most four-year institutions in Washington State as a major in Fine Arts. Portfolio presentation is usually the determining factor in acceptance for a Fine Arts Major, and this degree provides the structure for the preparation of a strong portfolio.

Students interested in pursuing the AFA degree should contact an Art advisor at the beginning of their program of study.
