

SCC General Education Outcome

Global Awareness Outcome

“Students will demonstrate understanding and awareness of issues related to, and consequences of, the growing global interdependence of diverse societies by integrating knowledge from multiple disciplines. Students will describe how social, cultural, political, and economic values and norms interact.”

Goal: Global Competence

Global Competence is the ability to understand and act on global issues. It is also a response to an increasingly complex and interdependent world.

A globally competent person is able to:

- 1) Understand global imperatives such as climate change, resource depletion, and world poverty;
- 2) Successfully navigate complex intercultural encounters with migrants and persons from other countries as they examine these imperatives;
- 3) Effectively communicate ideas, and
- 4) Participate in attempts to address these imperatives.


