

POLICY

IT SHALL BE THE POLICY OF SHORELINE COMMUNITY COLLEGE TO PRESERVE, IN A NATURAL STATE, THE ENTIRE AREA OF LAND FOUND IN THE EXTREME SOUTHEAST CORNER OF THE COLLEGE.

THE BOUNDARIES OF THIS AREA WILL BE: AS THE SOUTHERN BOUNDARY, INNIS ARDEN DRIVE; AS THE EASTERNMOST BOUNDARY, GREENWOOD AVENUE NORTH; AS THE NORTHERN AND WESTERNMOST BOUNDARIES, THE ENTRANCE ROAD TO THE COLLEGE EXTENDING FROM GREENWOOD AVENUE NORTH THROUGH THE EAST GATE OF THE COLLEGE, THROUGH THE MAIN GATE OF THE COLLEGE TO INNIS ARDEN DRIVE.

THIS AREA SHALL BE PRESERVED AS A NATURAL AREA FREE OF ANY KIND OF CONSTRUCTION OR DEVELOPMENT OTHER THAN THAT IN EXISTENCE AS OF JANUARY 31, 1973.
