Procedural Guidelines

The adaptation of an official College mascot must proceed through the following steps:

1. Questions of “good taste” and “reference to any racial, ethnic, or religious group” mentioned in the policy above will be determined by the Public Information Officer, the Student Body Association Executive Board and the Student Board Association Senate.
2. The mascot selected by the vote of enrolled students in an official election conducted by the Student Body Association Executive Board and validated by the Student Body Association Senate.
3. The mascot selected in the student election will be brought to the College Cabinet for its recommendation to the College president.
4. The College president will make his/her recommendation to the Board of Trustees for their final decision.
