FACULTY ADVISEMENT

PROCEDURAL GUIDELINES

All students will be assigned to and encouraged to consult with a faculty adviser. The signature of the faculty adviser will be required on the registration form only for students who

- a) are taking English as a Second Language (ESL) classes,
- b) are non-immigrants attending Shoreline on a visa,
- c) are pursuing a vocational degree program which requires a competitive admission process, or
- d) are attending Shoreline in the Running Start Program or High School Completion Program.
