You, and at least one parent if you are a dependent student, must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and required documents to the Financial Aid Office. We may ask for additional information. If you have questions about verification, contact us as soon as possible so that your financial aid is not delayed.

An	individual who was the victim of IRS tax-related identity theft must provide:
	A <b>2021 Tax Return DataBase View (TRDBV)</b> transcript obtained from the IRS by calling 1-800-908-4490, or any other IRS tax transcript(s) that includes all the income and tax information required to be verified; <b>AND</b>
	A statement signed and dated by the tax filer indicating that he or she was a victim of IRS tax-related identity theft and that the IRS is aware of the tax-related identity theft.
