



# Consent to Redisclose Federal Tax Information

As part of an application for financial aid using the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) form, aid applicants and contributors to the aid applicant’s form consent to the transfer of their federal tax information (FTI)\* from the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) directly to the FAFSA® form. The Financial Aid Office receives this information for use in administering financial aid awards.

The Financial Aid Office may not redisclose the FTI transferred from the IRS to an aid applicant’s FAFSA® form (including to other college departments) without separate, written consent from the aid applicant. The FTI data disclosed may only be used for the application, award, and administration of aid that is within the applicant’s cost of attendance. In addition, FTI data may not be discussed with any other individual without the explicit written consent of the aid applicant.

When requested by the aid applicant and on a case-by-case basis, this form will be used to provide consent for the applicable institution to release FTI for the indicated approved purposes only.

*\*Per the IRS definition FTI includes the following information: tax year, tax filing status, adjusted gross income (AGI), number of exemptions and dependents (household size), income earned from work, taxes paid, educational credits, untaxed Individual Retirement Arrangement (IRA or Individual Retirement Account) distributions, IRA deductible and payments, tax exempt interest, untaxed pensions and annuities, Schedule C net profits/losses, indicators for Schedules A, B, D, E, F, and/or H, IRS response code which indicates the status of the tax filer/FTI with the IRS to include one of the following: tax filer and FTI provided to the FTI Module (FTIM), not found at the IRS, found and a non-filer, found but IRS not able to provide information.*
