





In order to benefit both McNeese State University and Shoreline Community College in the recruitment of international students, and to assist international students in their educational planning and in the completion of a baccalaureate degree, McNeese State University and Shoreline Community College wish to enter into an agreement of conditional guaranteed admission.

Under this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU), McNeese State University will admit qualified current and prospective Shoreline Community College students into the University. McNeese State University agrees to define qualified Shoreline Community College students as those who have:

- Completed or will complete 90 college-level, transferrable credits;
- Achieved a minimum cumulative college-level GPA of 2.5 on all academic coursework (at all colleges attended, if student has attended other institutions in addition to Shoreline Community College);
- Met McNeese State University English proficiency and math requirements (successful completion, with a grade equivalent to a "C" [2.0] or better, of college-level English and Math at Shoreline Community College will be accepted to meet this requirement);
- Submitted a complete transfer application and all required documents by the applicable admission deadline.

McNeese State University and Shoreline Community College agree that:

- Shoreline Community College will inform prospective international students of this partnership.
- McNeese State University will provide Shoreline Community College with a "Conditional Letter of Admission" template.
- Shoreline Community College will mail a McNeese State University "Conditional Letter of Admission" to all international students who select McNeese State University.
- Shoreline Community College will provide McNeese State University with the contact information of students who chose McNeese State University guaranteed conditional admission.
- Shoreline Community College will invite McNeese State University to attend transfer events on its campus.

In order to complete the admissions process to attend McNeese State University, a current Shoreline Community College student must submit the following by the published application deadline:

- International Student Application (available online);
- An affidavit of support and bank letter;
- Copy of bio page of passport;
- Official transcript(s)

This MOU will be valid when it is signed by both the respective McNeese State University representative and the Shoreline Community College representative.
