



Articulation Agreement Between the Purchasing and Supply Chain Management Associate in Applied Arts and Sciences (AAAS) of Shoreline Community College and the International Business Bachelor of Applied Science (B.A.S.) of North Seattle College

March 1, 2018

The purpose of this agreement is to foster a spirit of collaboration between the two educational institutions named herein and the departments of appropriate degree programs. This agreement will facilitate qualified graduates of the Purchasing and Supply Chain Management Associate of Applied Arts and Sciences (PSCM AAAS) of Shoreline Community College to enroll at North Seattle College and complete the International Business Bachelor of Applied Science (IB B.A.S.) degree.

Graduates of Shoreline Community College's PSCM AAAS will be qualified to enroll in and complete the IB B.A.S. program at North Seattle College and receive a Bachelor of Applied Science degree in International Business.

Admission Requirements

All students must meet the following requirements of admission to enroll the International Business B.A.S. Degree at North Seattle College:

1. Completion of the PSCM AAAS at Shoreline Community College
2. Cumulative GPA of 2.0 GPA or above from all prior college/university coursework
3. Completion of IB B.A.S. program prerequisites with a 2.0 GPA or higher in each course (ENGL& 101, ACCT& 201, ACCT& 202, ACCT& 203, BUS& 201, and MATH& 146 or other statistics course)
4. Provide official transcripts from all colleges/universities attended
5. Completion of IB B.A.S. application packet including:
 - a) Personal information application form
 - b) Personal statement
 - c) Résumé
 - d) Payment of application fee which may vary from time to time.

PSCM AAAS graduates who meet these admission requirements are eligible for guaranteed acceptance into the International Business B.A.S. degree if the following additional requirements have been met:

1. Program application submitted prior to the first priority deadline of March 15th (program application submitted by March 15 will be for acceptance in the following fall quarter)
2. Cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher, or faculty approval
3. Completion of IB B.A.S program prerequisites with a 2.5 GPA or higher in each course, or faculty approval

Under this agreement Shoreline Community College and the PSCM AAAS program will:

1. Provide information regarding IB B.A.S. pathway for PSCM AAAS students on PSCM program Planning Guide including:
 - a. Indication that ENGL& 101 is required for IB B.A.S. admission
 - b. Guaranteed acceptance requirements
2. Email PSCM AAAS graduates to inform them of the new pathway.
3. Provide informational documents for distribution to potential students.

- 4. Both NSC and Shoreline will share use of the college logos when developing pathway marketing materials.
- 5. Conduct other communication efforts to prospective students as agreed upon between the institutions.

Under this agreement North Seattle College and the IB B.A.S. program will:

- 1. Automatically accept PSCM AAAS students into the International Business B.A.S. degree, contingent on the completion all admission requirements listed in this document including submission of IB B.A.S. application before the first priority application deadline (applications received after the first priority application deadline will be reviewed and considered along with all other applicants to the program).
- 2. Attend winter and spring transfer fairs at Shoreline Community College.
- 3. Provide dedicated international business advising for PSCM AAAS students.
- 4. Create dedicated program website landing page for potential students.
- 5. Conduct other communication efforts to prospective students as agreed upon between the institutions.

This agreement is intended to foster cooperation between faculty from each respective program and institution for review and coordination of curriculum.

Course equivalencies, substitutions, and waivers completed in the PSCM AAAS degree will be evaluated and honored on a case-by-case basis for use in the IB B.A.S. degree

It is agreed upon and understood that each party has the right and responsibility to make changes to its curricula and enrollment standards to maintain its academic integrity and meet accreditation standards. Such changes, if any, will be communicated in writing between respective administrators as they occur.

This articulation agreement, once signed will be effective immediately and must be reviewed and re-approved in the same manner at least once every three years.
