



ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

Central Washington University (CWU) and Shoreline Community College hereby establish an articulation agreement leading to a Bachelor of Art degree in Art. The degree will be conferred by CWU.

This agreement will begin in the 2014/15 academic year. The parties to this agreement commit to offering this program until dissolved by mutual agreement. An evaluation of the program will be conducted every three years.

Students from Shoreline Community College will earn the Associate of Fine Arts Direct Transfer Agreement (DTA) and will normally transfer to CWU as junior standing and automatically satisfy the Basic & Breadth requirements at CWU.

Upon completion of the program courses as shown in **Exhibit A** and the meeting of all graduation requirements a Bachelor of Art* degree in Art will be awarded. Students must complete a minimum of 45 credits at CWU, 60 credits of upper division credits (300/400), a minimum total of 180 credits, achieve a cumulative grade-point average (GPA) of at least 2.0 in courses taken at CWU, and achieve a cumulative grade-point average (GPA) of at least 2.5 in the major to graduate. **Exhibit B** provides associate degree requirements and its equivalencies.

*Students seeking a Bachelor in Arts degree must complete one year college/university study of a single foreign language or have completed two years high school study of a single foreign language.

Tuition will be billed to each student at CWU's prevailing cost-per-credit rate for all courses.

Admission requirements for CWU are as follows:

- 1) Completed CWU Application for Admission (application can be found at <http://www.cwu.edu/admissions/apply-now>).
- 2) A non-refundable \$50 application fee is required. Students submitting an application online must pay by using a credit (Visa or Mastercard) or debit card. Your application will not be processed until your \$50 application fee has been paid. Please follow the instructions at the end of the online application carefully.
- 3) Once online payment has been made, **DO NOT** close your browser. Follow the steps below.
 - a) You **MUST** click on the SUBMIT button on bottom right side of the page.
 - b) You will then be returned to the application and you must click SUBMIT on the top right side.

(If you do not submit the application after the payment is made CWU will not receive your application and it will not be processed.)
- 4) You are now ready to start the online application process. Click on the link below to select the appropriate online application.
- 5) Students transferring to CWU with the AFA-DTA must have a minimum cumulative transferable grade point average of 2.0 from all colleges or universities previously attended.

Admission requirements for the Department of Art at CWU are as follows:

Students having completed the SCC AFA-Foundation Studio Art degree and transferring to CWU can begin their studies directly as **BA-Art Majors**.

CWU Art Core Courses: SCC students completing the SCC AFA- Foundation Studio Art degree, including all three courses in the Western Art History sequence (Art History 224, 225 and 226), will satisfy all lower division requirements of CWU's Art Core Requirements for both BA and BFA Studio Art Majors.

CWU Lower Division Studio Art Electives: The SCC AFA- Foundation Studio Art studio art courses listed in **Exhibit B**, taken as concentration electives for the AFA- Foundation Studio Art degree, can be counted toward the requirement of 5 Lower Division Studio Art electives for the CWU BA Art Major. Additionally, ART 133 Drawing 3, which is taken as an AFA core requirement, will also count as a CWU Lower Division Studio Art Elective.

All enrolled students are eligible to apply for financial aid at CWU. Each student's situation will be evaluated on an individual basis. Students must apply for financial assistance through CWU's Financial Aid Office.




