Currently, Portland State University has a transfer agreement with Clark Community College in Vancouver, Washington. Because of our success with Clark College and similarities between the Oregon Block Transfer degree and the Washington Direct Transfer degree, Portland State University would like to extend this agreement to include all Washington Community Colleges.

Effective Fall term, 1994 any student who has earned the Washington Direct Transfer AA degree as outlined in the ICRC guidelines will be considered to have met the lower-division general education requirements at Portland State University. This policy change will apply to all past and future degrees awarded under the ICRC guidelines in effect at the time the degree was awarded.

We have been pleased with our relationship with the community colleges in the state of Washington and the performance of the students who have transferred to our University. We hope this agreement signals the beginning of even more cooperation between the Washington Community Colleges and Portland State University.
