- We may be able to accept your [Free Application for Federal Student Aid](#) (FAFSA) after the recommended submission deadlines listed above. However, applications received after the recommended submission deadlines are not guaranteed to be processed by the start of the quarter.
- Students with an active aid offer will have their payment of tuition deadline deferred through a protective hold (called a “service indicator”) on their account in ctcLink. Please contact our Financial Aid Department at financialaid@shoreline.edu or call **(206) 546-4762** if you do not see a service indicator on your account and believe you should have one.
- A financial aid refund is the money you receive after all your aid has been disbursed to your student account to cover tuition and fees to attend Shoreline Community College each quarter. If your financial aid exceeds your costs, the leftover funds are refunded to you through our college's third-party servicer, [BankMobile](#). For example, if your tuition and fees total \$4000 this quarter but your aid is \$5000, you can receive a financial aid refund of \$1000. *
