

Operating Performance: FY 2013 Net Income vs. Budget (through December 2012)






Types and Sources of Revenue

Type of Revenue	Source	Degree of Control Exerted by College
State Appropriations	State / Legislature	Low
Fees	Students	Low (Initiative 1185, passed in 2012, <i>current status?</i>)
Tuition	Students	Low
Auxiliary Services	Students, Staff, Community	Medium, limited by supply/demand
Grants & Contracts	Multiple (State, Federal, Public, Private, Int'l)	Medium – Potentially High
Strategic Initiatives (Virtual College, International Education)	New Students	High




SCC Revenue Trends: 2009-2013




Virtual College: Enrollment in Online Classes @ SCC

- Strategic plan for next steps




Increase in International Student Tuition Revenue (*net of increase*) vs. PY






Percentage of Overall Revenue from International Education: FY 2009-2014 (proj.)






International Students: ROI FY 2009-2013






Impact of International Student Recruitment on Financial Stability (<u>net of tuition increase</u>)


