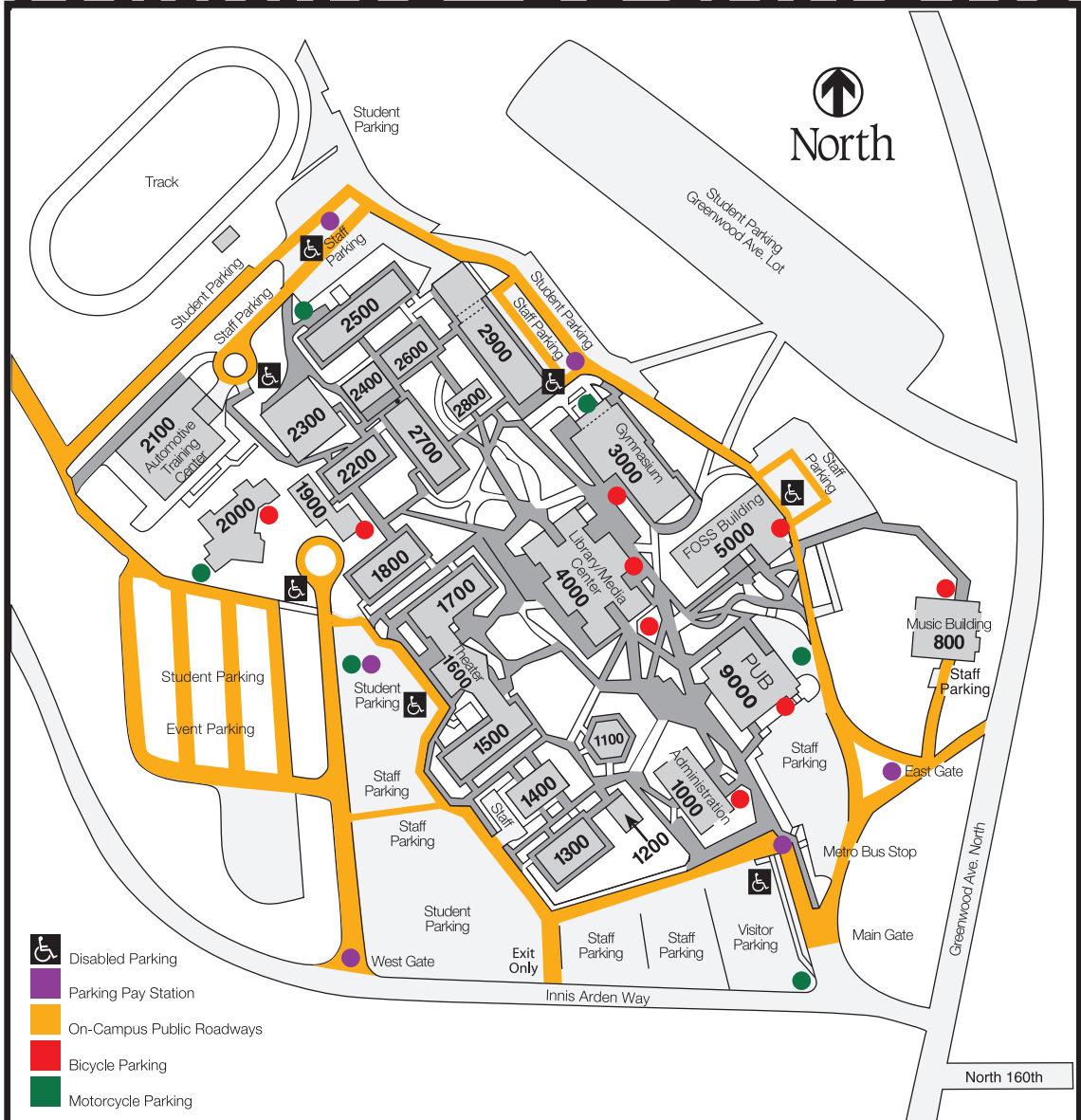


BICYCLE & MOTORCYCLE PARKING LOCATIONS



General Parking Regulations

All vehicles must have a valid college parking permit, properly displayed, while parked on the campus. Student permits are not valid in the Visitors Lot. Vehicles parked in disabled person spaces must display a state-issued disabled placard or license plate and a Shoreline CC parking permit at all times.

Student parking spaces require a valid student quarter permit or a single day permit, Monday through Friday from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. (the campus is closed from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.).

Motorcycles do not need a permit however, motorcycles parked in a space other than a designated motorcycle area will be cited.

Bicycle Parking On Campus

Bicycles shall be parked in bicycle racks or other facilities provided for that purpose. At no time shall a bicycle be parked in a building, against a building exit, on a path or sidewalk, nor chained or otherwise secured to trees, lamp standards, or sign posts, nor parked in such a way as to obstruct access to any college property or to endanger any pedestrian right of way. Any bicycle found in violation of this section may be cited for illegal parking and impounded by the college safety/security department without warning. The citation carries a \$25.00 fine. (WAC 132G-116-205)
