

8U21 (Delta Epsilon Chi): The \$1,900 cut to the DEC program will eliminate State Conference Registration Fees that the organization asks for which will in turn cause the students to be expected to pay for registration fees along with the dues that they already pay.

5U31/5U32 (Athletics): The \$76,927 cut from the requested amount from Athletics will eliminate both tennis teams along with cutting approximately \$50,000 worth of scholarships for the remaining teams.

5U71 (Intramurals): The cut of \$2852 from the Intramurals budget will decrease the amount of hours that the gym is open for students during the academic year which brings in over 500 students each quarter for extracurricular activities.

Clubs/Student Activity Groups: There will only be \$32,000 allocated to Category I Organizations, which will reduce the club baseline budget from \$500 to \$250. This budget has already been cut from \$1000 and \$2500 in the past and forces the clubs to go through supplemental for almost any activity that a club wants to host.

Club Supplemental: This will also decrease the prospected amount of \$100,000 as a set amount for the supplemental down to \$65,172. This year, the SBA has allocated more than this amount from the club supplemental and there are going to be a greater amount of requests from clubs and organizations because of the cut to all of the budgets.

SBA Contingency: The SBA Contingency will be \$0 this year which will mean no extra funding will be put into the Student savings fund.
