Study Abroad Scholarship Information

The Study Abroad Scholarship Committee will offer study abroad scholarships. Up to \$12,000 in awards will be given out, with awards ranging from \$900 to \$1,200. Awards are for use on Shoreline Summer Institutes only and must be used in the year they are awarded. Award amounts will be based on the cost of the study abroad program. The Study Abroad Scholarship committee will choose recipients based on the quality of the personal resume, essay, and transcript.

Scholarships are non-renewable. The scholarship dollars will be applied to the <u>final payment</u> of the program fee. Award payments will be made to the College on behalf of the recipient. Scholarship recipients are expected to work with the Study Abroad Manager upon return to share their study abroad experience with other students (for example talking at a study abroad info meeting, sharing photos or writings for use on the school website or other marketing materials).

Applications are DUE by 4pm on March 6, 2017.

Eligibility Requirements:

- Must have been enrolled at Shoreline at least 2 quarters between Fall 2015 and Winter 2017.
- Must be applying to or accepted into a 2017 Shoreline Summer Institute
- Must be a U.S. Citizen or permanent resident
- Must show Financial Need AND/OR be from a population that is underrepresented in Study Abroad programs. This includes students who are any of the following:
 - 1) first-generation college students 2) ethnically diverse 3) 24 years or older 4) STEM students

Application Requirements:

- Completed Application Form with Signature
- Current Unofficial Shoreline Community College Transcript
- Essay
- Resume

Determination of Award:

The application will be reviewed by the Study Abroad Scholarship Committee. Recipients will be notified of their award no later than April 7, 2017.
