- Application considered regardless of previous associate, bachelor or advanced degree(s)

- 3. SCC Unofficial Transcript
- 4. One page typed personal essay stating your educational and career goals and special needs.
- 5. Letter of recommendation from an adult who knows you well and can describe your characteristics, performances, experiences, strengths, knowledge, and capabilities.

Recipient will be selected based on GPA, quality of essay submitted, and professional integrity and motivation. Selection committee will consist of Health Occupations faculty and/or MLT Advisory committee members.
