- COMPLETING YOUR HIGH SCHOOL HISTORY AND CIVICS REQUIREMENTS AT BYU •

GOOD OPTION FOR:

- Students who need to complete their U.S History requirement when HIST 037 is not available and do not want to take college-level history
- Students who need to complete their Civics requirement and do not want to take college-level political science

**Note: BYU courses are high school courses and will NOT count toward your college degree requirements.*

HOW TO TAKE A BYU COURSE:

1. Decide which classes you want to complete at BYU
 - **U.S. History:** you must take two courses (HIST 041 & HIST 043)
 - **U.S. Government:** one course required (GOVT 041)
 - You can choose the teacher-led option or the online-only option
2. Register for your course(s) on BYU's website:
