Hosting Japanese Students

Shoreline Community College recently hosted more than **400** high school students and teachers from Japan, officials from the Japanese Consulate in Seattle and the Laurasian foundation. The visit on March 20 was part of the Kakehashi Project, a large-scale youth exchange program between the U.S. and Japan. The project is funded by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Japan with the goal of enhancing international understanding of Japan and its strengths and attractions.

The students were given a tour of the campus, met with international education representatives and participate in a student panel discussion with current international students at Shoreline.

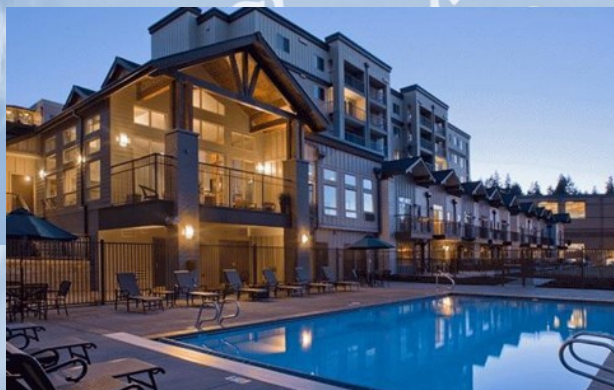

TOEFL & IELTS REQUIREMENTS

Shoreline does not require **TOEFL** or **IELTS** for admission purposes.

If you have taken one of the following English assessment tests in the last 2 years and received a high score (see below), you may be eligible to enroll directly into college-level English or get placed at a higher ESL level.

TOEFL

72 (iBT), with writing sub-score of 21

IELTS

Overall band score of 6.0, with writing section score of 6.0
