Ecuador is a country of staggering diversity but also high economic disparity. Access to healthcare in Ecuador is often inequitable. The itinerary explores the diversity of factors, including geography, education, economics, religion, and politics, that affect Ecuadorians' health and access to health services. Through visits to health institutions, service learning in urban and rural settings, and a visit to a respected university health center, students will gain insight into the unique challenges and a variety of solutions to providing healthcare in Ecuador.
