- 1. Apply for admission to Shoreline Community College. Indicate your interest in receiving conditional guaranteed admission to Carroll College on your Shoreline application.
- 2. Receive an admission letter from Shoreline Community College, as well as a conditional guaranteed admission letter to Carroll College AT THE SAME TIME!
- 3. Take your admission letters, along with your I-20 document, to the U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for your F-1 visa.
- 4. Enroll at Shoreline and finish the first half of your Bachelor's degree by earning an A.A. or A.S. degree.
- 5. Transfer to Carroll College to finish the second half of your Bachelor's degree.
- 6. Complete your Bachelor's degree from Carroll College!

Conditional Guaranteed Transfer Admission to Carroll College Requires:

- Earn an A.A. or A.S. degree from Shoreline Community College or complete a minimum of 45 transferable quarter credits with a minimum 2.8 GPA by the time of transfer;
- Be in good academic standing in the last term, with a minimum quarterly GPA of 2.0;
- Have earned a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA in courses required for the chosen major;
- Complete math 099 (intermediate algebra) or a higher level math course with a grade of "C"/2.0 or higher prior to enrolling at Carroll College;
- Complete English 102 with a grade of "C"/2.0 or higher prior to enrolling at Carroll College if you will not earn the Shoreline Community College A.A. or A.S. degree.
- NOTE: This agreement is valid for admission to any undergraduate major at Carroll College with the exception of Nursing.
