- 3. Take your admission letters, along with your I-20 document, to the U.S. embassy or consulate and apply for your F-1 visa.
- 4. Enroll at Shoreline and finish the first half of your Bachelor's degree by earning an A.A. or A.S. degree.
- 5. Transfer to Concordia College to finish the second half of your Bachelor's degree.
- 6. Complete your Bachelor's degree from Concordia College!

Conditional Guaranteed Transfer Admission to Concordia College Requires:

- Study at Shoreline and obtain a GPA of 2.75 or higher;
- Complete courses ENGL 101 and 102 with average grade B-/2.5 or higher;
- If you have not graduated from secondary school, you must complete at least one academic year with a minimum 45 quarter credits at Shoreline before transferring.
- The usual application fee will be waived for Shoreline students applying to Concordia College under this conditional guaranteed transfer admission agreement.
