International Programs -SCC's International Education Resource

The International Program at SCC contributes to our institution's strategic plan by delivering comprehensive international education resources and services to the SCC campus community.

International Student Services

The International Program assists more than 450 Non-resident International Students from 40 countries.

International Programs' staff members are available to assist the SCC campus community with understanding the unique needs of international students.

Study-Teach Abroad Programs

SCC values international study-teach abroad programs as an important component of a comprehensive education.

The College belongs to the Washington Consortium for Study Abroad (WCCCSA) which offers study-teach abroad quarter-long programs in Europe and Costa Rica.

In addition, the International Program assists SCC faculty develop customized credit-bearing international study-abroad and service-learning programs. Recent programs include Japan, South Africa, Greece and Turkey, Thailand and Ireland.

International Training Services
