

MLK Day of Service ON CAMPUS FOOD DRIVE

As part of the MLK Day of Service Food Drive we are hosting an ON CAMPUS food drive to help alleviate hunger for SCC students. From **Jan. 7-31st** we will collect emergency food items at various sites on campus. ***All food collected on campus will stay on campus.***

The majority of the food collected will go to create Emergency Bags. E-bags provide enough food for hungry individuals to last until they can access community food resources. Each E-bag comes with a packet of information on community resources.

E-bags will be distributed through the Center for Equity, Engagement and Service; Learning Center North and Career Education Options.

Emergency Bag Packing Lists (Single Person size)

2 small boxes/cans of juice

1 Can* or 2 cups of Fruit

1 Can* Soup (pop-top or microwavable)

1 Can* Meal (Chili, Pork & Beans or Other)

1 Can* or single-service pouch Tuna/Chicken

2 single-serving pouches Oatmeal

1 Sleeve Saltine or Ritz Crackers

2 Snacks (e.g.: granola/fruit bars, nuts, raisins, cheese/peanut butter and crackers)

***Please donate only CANNED ITEMS WITH POP-TOPS – easy open for those without can openers**

Friendly Reminder: Please check expiration dates to ensure longer shelf life!


How it works:
