Information for Teachers Regarding the ABE Student Assessment during the 2016-2017 School Year

The Amgen Biotechnology Experience (ABE) has existed for 25 years but as of yet no systematic information has been collected regarding what students have learned from ABE. During the 2016-2017 school year, the Amgen Foundation has required that WestEd evaluators obtain additional evidence of the effectiveness for the ABE Program. WestEd will have students of some ABE teachers take a test that covers the content and skills found in ABE. The assessment will be used only for ABE program-wide statements. It will **not** be used for comparing program sites or teachers.

The assessment is a short pre-test taken by students before the ABE lessons and a short posttest taken after the ABE lessons. A random sample of teachers will be selected to participate in the student assessment.

For the sampling strategy to be adequately representative of the ABE program, all teachers who request and use ABE materials during the 2016-2017 school year will need to participate in the student assessment study, if they are selected.

Selected teachers will be required to administer the pre-test and post-test to at least one of their classes which have ABE lessons. Teacher can have additional classes participate in the student assessment.
